## COURSE OVERVIEW

The First Level Degree Course in Accounting, Management and Economics is intended for high-school graduates interested in acquiring a good grounding in the study of businesses seen in a systemic perspective, as composite and uniform organizations, and in the economical, social and institutional context in which they operate.

The curriculum also includes subjects connected with business accounting aspects, economic-financial communication, management planning and economic control, accounting and management auditing, financial planning and the choice of financial sources, tax management, business organization and management of human resources.

## CAREER PROSPECTS

The degree course aims to train the following professional figures:

- experts in business administration, accounting and financial reporting, planning and control, finance, management of human resources;
- junior experts in consulting and auditing companies;
- expert bookkeepers (section B of the Professional Register);
- auditors;
- labour consultants.

Graduates can find employment as administrative and accounting junior professionals with private and public companies, small, medium-sized and big businesses; with accountancy firms and auditing companies; with financial institutions as junior experts in budget analysis.

## SYLLABUS

The curriculum encompasses 17 core modules (10, 8 or 6 ECTS), 3 elective modules (6 ECTS) and a lab module.

Core subjects focussing on the principles, systems and techniques of business administration are complemented with activities aimed at the acquisition of the necessary legal, economic and statistical-mathematical tools, as well as of business English. Elective modules provide an in-depth understanding of relevant professional topics, transport companies, state bodies and human resources.

During the second year of study, the student can choose between two curriculums: one focused on private companies, while the other one, on public companies.

Along with traditional lectures, students can avail themselves of the e-learning platform to complete their study, take part in seminars, workshops and professional testimonies aimed at facilitating their entry into the job market.
