## COURSE OVERVIEW

The Master's Degree Course in Accounting and Management Consulting is intended for graduates interested in deepening their knowledge of business governance and control, and pursuing a career as business executives or self-employed external consultants. In particular, the master's course is designed to develop key skills concerning choices, systems and tools in the area of business administration, finance and control; the management of information-accounting systems, with specific reference to their accuracy and reliability; the representation and interpretation of business management and performance dynamics by means of accounting matrix models; the strategic and administrative management of exceptional phases in a company's life; business valuation; the definition of business and network governance layout.

## CAREER PROSPECTS

The master's degree course aims to train:

- Chief Financial Officers, Controllers, Internal Auditors;
- accountants and business consultants;
- accounting auditors.

Graduates can find employment as administrative, financial and junior control professionals with small, medium-sized and big businesses; with accountancy firms; with consulting and auditing companies.

## SYLLABUS

The syllabus comprises 10 core modules (10 or 6 ECTS) and 2 elective modules (6 ECTS credits each).

Core modules in the economic-business area are complemented with the study of connected topics pertaining to the legal and economic aspects of governance, the management of exceptional phases in a company's life, the economic-financial external communication, administration and control of business processes and resources, management of fiscal variables.

Along with traditional lectures, students can avail themselves of the e-learning platform to complete their study, take part in seminars, workshops and professional testimonies aimed at facilitating their entry into the job market. Students can also benefit from internships and periods of study abroad. The degree course culminates in a final examination (thesis defence).
