COURSE OVERVIEW

The five-year degree course in Law aims to provide students with the theoretical and operational knowledge and with the professional tools necessary to fully understand the complexity of the legal orders and their interrelations, in an analytical and practical perspective.

CAREER PROSPECTS

Traditional legal subject areas are complemented with an interdisciplinary programme. In an integrated perspective, together with national, international and European legal units, students are brought to acquire the basics of economic and business studies with the specific objective of enabling them to enter in the productive world of business and find a place in state and private companies, which operate both nationally and internationally, as well as locally.

The course is designed for the training of three professional figures, one more general and the other two more specialized:

1. Jurist:

It includes all the conventional legal professions (lawyers, notaries, judges), upon completion of the access procedures provided for by law.

2. Business jurist:

Graduates can find work in commercial enterprises or as business legal advisors.

3. Jurist for public bodies and administrations:

Managers or officials in public bodies; self-employed legal consultants.

SYLLABUS

The syllabus is structured into five years and enables students to gain a proper knowledge through the study of legal and economical subjects. It provides an integrated perspective on legal issues connected to the regulation and government of economical, social and institutional phenomena. Students are led on the one hand to explore in depth the field of law through the study of the evolution of legal and historical methods ; on the other hand, to achieve a greater awareness of business and economic topics, which facilitates their access to the private job market.
