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COURSE OVERVIEW

The Degree in Economics prepares students for understanding structure and functioning of real economic systems and financial markets.

Classes and teaching methodology are interdisciplinary, combining the acquisition of skills along different dimensions of Economics (micro- and macroeconomics, economic policy, finance, econometrics) with expertise in business studies (financial accounting, business organization and corporate finance), a solid methodological grounding in economic analysis (mathematics and statistics), and a thorough knowledge of the basics of trade, public and private law.

The syllabus consists of 19 classes in the economic, business, statistical-mathematical and legal areas (with core and and elective classes), an IT and a foreign language unit, and a final examination (oral defence) totalling 180 ECTS.

CAREER PROSPECTS

Our graduates (can) works in economic and strategic consulting companies, financial intermediaries, banks, central Banks, consulting firms, insurance companies, research offices, public administration and Institutions, trade unions.

SYLLABUS

Classes in the first year present basic skills in economic, business, mathematics, and law. In the second and third years students continue their studies of economic subjects (with regard to economic policies, the dynamic of real and financial markets), and law .

The course also offers the opportunity to deepen and consolidate foreign language and IT skills. A written thesis, with oral defence, completes the course. All lessons and teaching materials (slides, additional readings, problem sets) can be accessed through e-learning platform (Moodle); “blended” courses, using slides with audio commentary, multimedia documents, self-evaluation tests, are progressively added to the courseware ; interactive sessions (via chat or web conference) are available with the tutors upon appointment. In addition, the platform allows students to manage: group work, discussion forums and class messaging.
